

Rules and Requirements for Performance Classes for the GCSMP Playdays

- Horses of all ages may be shown in a snaffle, bosal or curb bit.
- All horses must be shown in split reins or romal reins
- Horses shown in bosal can use mecate reins.
- Snaffle bit shall be a “D” or “O” ring type, with broken mouth
- Only a leather or woven fabric chinstrap may be used on snaffle bit.
- Snaffle bit horses can be shown two handed
- A leather, rawhide covered or flat chain curb chain must be used on curb bits
- No mechanical hackamores, gag bits, cavassons, tiedowns, or martingales may be used when showing
- Horses exhibited in curb bits must be shown one handed, with only one finger between split reins or no fingers between romal reins.
- Horse boots or leg wraps cannot be used while showing in trail class

Rules and Requirements for Rider Attire

- Rider may wear protective headgear in all classes
- Rider must wear western hat or protective headgear in all classes
- Rider must wear long-sleeved western or button-down shirt
- Judge may allow short-sleeve western or button-down shirt
- Rider must wear western style jeans
- Rider must wear western or lace-up western style boots. No riding shoes allowed
- Spurs, chaps or chinks or optional
